### **Return to School for Pupils in some Year Groups**

I am writing to let you know that headteachers and staff at all four schools are working very hard to plan for the return of pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 providing the Government and the scientific advisers states it is safe to do so.

Our schools are finalising plans and I should be able to let you know very soon the target dates we have set for different year groups to return and the measures we are putting in place to mitigate as much risk as possible.

If you have not yet completed and returned a medical form for your child, please do this as soon as you are able.

Next week, headteachers will be walking through their risk assessments, ensuring that staff are trained in new ways of working and that classrooms are ready to receive small groups of pupils. Only Key worker children and vulnerable pupils will continue to come to school from 1<sup>st</sup> June.

Our target date to begin to welcome back wider groups of pupils is **8<sup>th</sup> June**.

Our on line learning community will begin again on 1<sup>st</sup> June and we look forward to welcoming children back to on line classrooms.
